

APA Exemptions Specifically Noted in Virginia Code (Category B)

2.2-717(F) Actions of the Department relating to the review, allocation and awarding of grants shall be exempt from the provisions of the Administrative Process Act (§ [2.2-4000](#) et seq.) pursuant to subdivision B 4 of § [2.2-4002](#). Decisions of the Department shall be final and not subject to review or appeal. **2001 Va. Acts ch. 844.** (Respite Care Grants)

2.2-1403(8) Adopt regulations to implement certification programs for small, women- and minority-owned businesses, which regulations shall be exempt from the Administrative Process Act (§ [2.2-4000](#) et seq.) pursuant to subdivision B 2 of § [2.2-4002](#). **2006 Va. Acts ch. 831.**

2.2-4103 Orders condemning or closing any shellfish, finfish or crustacea growing area and the shellfish, finfish or crustacea located thereon pursuant to Article 2 (§ [28.2-803](#) et seq.) of Chapter 8, of Title 28.2, which are exempt from the requirements of the Administrative Process Act (§ [2.2-4000](#) et seq.) as provided in subsection B of § [2.2-4002](#), shall be effective on the date specified by the promulgating agency. **2001 Va. Acts ch. 844.**

2.2-5104(F) Actions of the Partnership relating to the allocation and awarding of grants shall be exempt from the provisions of the Administrative Process Act (§ [2.2-4000](#) et seq.) pursuant to subdivision B 4 of § [2.2-4002](#). **2001 Va. Acts ch. 844.** (Investment Partnership Act)

3.1-437.1 In accordance with the Administrative Process Act, § [2.2-4000](#) et seq. and in particular § [2.2-4002](#) thereof, the Commission may establish minimum retail prices on an emergency basis, prior to public hearing. **1974 Va. Acts ch. 467.**

8.01-216.18(G) Any documentary material, answers to written interrogatories, or oral testimony provided under any civil investigative demand issued under this article shall be exempt from disclosure under the Virginia Administrative Process Act (§ [2.2-4000](#) et seq.). **2002 Va. Acts ch. 842.** (Fraud Against Taxpayers Act)

36-100 The adoption, amendment, or repeal of any Code provisions shall be exempt from the Administrative Process Act, Chapter 40 (§ [2.2-4000](#) et seq.) of Title 2.2, pursuant to subdivision A 13 of § [2.2-4006](#). Before the adoption, amendment, or repeal of any Code provisions, the Board shall hold at least one public hearing. In addition to the notice requirement contained therein, the Board shall notify in writing the building official or, where none, the local governing body of every city or county in the Commonwealth. At any such hearing all persons desiring to do so shall be afforded an opportunity to present their views. **2006 Va. Acts ch. 719.** (Building Code)
